# **CAMP LOKANDA**

## **PACKING INFORMATION**

**PACKING THE “RIGHT STUFF”.** We know that packing for camp is a BIG job. So we want to help you out with some useful packing tips provided in our **Do’s and Don’ts** section below.

### **SOME IMPORTANT DO’s!**

**Do** follow our packing list carefully!

**Do** label **EVERYTHING** including clothing or other items that your child wears or brings on the bus. Also, be sure to label anything brought up on visiting day or sent to camp.

**Do** send sunscreen to camp. We suggest 2 spray bottles packed (2 more to bring on Visiting Day), 2 face sticks, and 1 lotion sunscreen (minimum).

**Do** send an extra pair of glasses, and protective sports glasses, if your child wears them.

**Do** send your camper with 4 refillable water bottles.

**Do** make sure batteries in fans and flashlights are NEW and items are in working order prior to sending them to camp. Check battery sizes and send extras!

**Do** consider putting a letter in your child’s trunk. For our younger campers, whose trunks are unpacked for them, it will be waiting on the bed when he/she arrives at camp!!

**Do** consider sending: a music player (mp3 with NO display or screen), a lockbox, a battery operated fan (no plug-in); and “fun tack” for photos or posters that your child will hang on bunk walls.

**Do** have your child come prepared for sports:

- **Baseball & Softball:** Campers must have a baseball/softball mitt, glove and protective cup (boys). Baseball pants are suggested.
- **Soccer:** Cleats and shin guards are required.
- **Tennis:** Tennis racket is required.
- **Roller Hockey and Rollerblading:** Yes – your camper will be learning how to skate so you must send rollerblades to camp. Additionally, all campers must have protective gear to skate, including knee and elbow pads, wrist guards and a helmet. The boys will be playing hockey and will need hockey gloves and a caged helmet. We have hockey sticks so one from home is optional, but not required.
- **Lacrosse:** We have equipment. If you’d like to bring a stick, you can, but it is not required.
- **Golf:** We have golf clubs for your camper to use in our golf program. Your camper may bring their own clubs if s(he) would like.
- **Gaga:** Some campers like to wear gloves when they play Gaga to protect the knuckles from being scraped. Baseball or softball batting gloves work well for this.

**Do** send CITs with a non-digital, regular watch to wear.

**Do** send items for our Theme Days: Every week we have a different theme day that we hope all staff and campers will participate in. This year the themes are:

- Hometown / Home Team Day (something to show what city or country you are from)
- July 4<sup>th</sup>
- Neon Day
- Crazy Hat and Sock Day
- Tie Dye Day

## SOME IMPORTANT DON'Ts!

### **DO NOT send (both plug-in and battery operated are not permitted)**

- flat irons
- curling irons
- crock pots
- extension cords
- electric fans (battery operated fans are OK)
- hot plates
- refrigerators
- microwaves
- walkie talkies
- any other electrical appliance (while not encouraged, blow dryers are still permitted)

### **DO NOT send any crop tops or "short shorts".**

### **DO NOT send bikinis, monokinis or sideless shirts.**

**DO NOT send more than one decorative pillow or stuffed animal** for your camper's bed. Extra pillows create a problem for bunk clean up and these items are difficult to keep clean.

**DO NOT send any oversized chairs.** For reference, please use "Crazy Creek" size chair.

### **DO NOT send any essential oils or any CBD oils.**

### **DO NOT send any wipes (not even flushable wipes).**

### **DO NOT send any water guns, blasters, soakers or pistols.**

### **DO NOT send any walkie talkies.**

**DO NOT add any locks** to your child's trunk or duffel bag. Their baggage is delivered directly to their bunks. We unpack all campers through grade 5 (current school grade) before they arrive at camp so we need to be able to open their baggage. All bags are subject to inspection.

**DO NOT pack or send expensive electronic devices, games, jewelry and watches.** Camp Lokanda WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for these items if they are lost, stolen or damaged. This also applies to expensive sports equipment, like tennis rackets, hockey equipment, etc.

### **DO NOT pack prohibited electronics** including:

- iPod Touch, iPod Nano
- Tablet Devices (iPads, iPad minis, Google Tablets, etc)
- eReaders (Kindles, Nooks etc)
- Hotspot devices
- Wireless headphones or anything with Bluetooth
- Apple watch or any other smart watches
- Fitbits or other fitness trackers
- Cell phones / Smart phones
- DVD Players, Blu Ray players
- Gaming systems including PSPs, Gameboys, Nintendo DS
- Cameras including Polaroid Cameras (e.g., Fujifilm Instax Mini)
- Video Cameras / Camcorders
- Go-Pros
- Laptop computers
- Walkie Talkies

**DO NOT pack ANY food, water or sports drinks** in your child's trunks. Trunks will be inspected upon their arrival at camp and such items will be removed and discarded.

### **DO NOT send your camper with any money and do NOT pack any money in their baggage.**

**DO NOT send your camper with expensive socks** as they often get lost in the laundry.

**DO NOT send bunk gifts** as it is against our rules.
